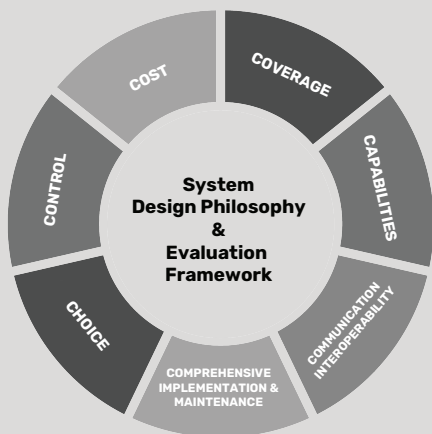

After serving four years in the Air Force, at the age 26, Jason achieved his goal to work on the streets of Phoenix as a rookie police officer. Then, only 14 months into his career, Jason's life took an unexpected tragic turn. On the night of March 26th, 2001, a taxicab crashed into the rear of Jason's patrol car. Upon impact, Jason's car burst into flames, trapping him inside.

Through a series of miraculous and fateful circumstances, Jason survived the crash and ensuing physical and emotional catastrophe. He suffered severe burns to over 40% of his body which drastically altered his appearance. He has undergone more than 50 surgeries just to have the ability to accomplish simple daily tasks we often take for granted.

In 2014, author Landon J. Napoleon published *Burning Shield: The Jason Schechterle Story* about Jason's unbelievable journey.

Jason's journey chronicles his fight for life, his triumph over tragedy and the inspiration that enables him to continue to overcome unimaginable adversity. His personal narrative exemplifies that the power of the human spirit can never be underestimated or extinguished.

Chief Jason Armstrong (retired)

Jason P. Armstrong is a retired police chief, National Law Enforcement Officer Hall of Fame inductee, and #1 best-selling author who helps leaders and organizations navigate challenges and change with confidence. Drawing from two decades of leadership experience, including leading reform as Police Chief in Ferguson, Missouri, Jason equips audiences with practical tools to solve challenges around trust, engagement, and organizational alignment. He has been featured on MSNBC, CNN, ABC News, and CBS News as a trusted voice on leadership and transformation. Through his keynotes and trainings, Jason helps corporations, associations, and public safety agencies break down silos, strengthen leadership pipelines, and create cultures that deliver measurable results. Audiences leave with clarity, confidence, and strategies to lead intentionally and achieve lasting impact.



Dr. Jaime (Brower) Achuleta



Dr. Jaime (Brower) Archuleta, Psy.D. is a licensed psychologist in Colorado and Wyoming. She is board-certified in Police & Public Safety Psychology by the American Board of Professional Psychology (ABPP) and is currently the American Board of Police and Public Safety Psychology's (ABPPSP) President Elect and National Chair of Examinations. She is also the Founder and Owner of Brower Psychological Services & Consulting, Inc. (BPS). She now serves as the Vice President of Peer Support and Clinician Training and Membership for Lexipol. Dr. Brower founded the National Emergency Responder and Public Safety Center (NERPSC, LLC), acquired by Lexipol in early 2023. Dr. Brower has devoted her career to working with those in law enforcement, corrections, detentions, fire, military, and other high stress occupations, as well as ensuring the health and wellbeing of their family members. She further specializes in risk and threat assessment, school violence and hostile workplace investigations. Dr. Brower is particularly passionate about training and consulting with agencies regarding best practices for enhancing resiliency and wellness. Dr. Brower is the proud recipient of the 2019 CIT Instructor of the Year award!

SAC Adam DeCamp



Adam DeCamp currently serves as a Special Agent in Charge for the Iowa Division of Criminal Investigation, bringing over 30 years of law enforcement experience to the role. While he has spent several years in leadership at headquarters, including a stint as Bureau Chief of the Professional Standards Bureau, Adam has dedicated most of his career to the Major Crime Unit (MCU). For the past seven years, Adam has overseen a team of MCU agents serving the south-central region of Iowa.

On January 4, 2024, a lone shooter inside Perry High School killed a student and a school administrator, injured six others, and terrorized an entire community before taking his own life. In the moments immediately following the shooting, Adam was the on-scene supervisor, leading the investigation into not only the incident itself, but also the pathway to violence the shooter traveled. Since the Perry High School shooting, Adam has remained committed to sharing the insights and lessons learned throughout the investigation. His goal is to support law enforcement agencies, officers, and investigators in strengthening their preparedness and response —before, during, and after critical incidents.

Sheriff Adam Infante



Sheriff Adam Infante is a competent and highly-committed leader whose resume includes a 26-year law enforcement career in the Dallas County Sheriff's Office where he has been dedicated to the people who live and work in Dallas County. Prior to being appointed Sheriff in 2022 and subsequently elected Sheriff in 2024, he was active as a Patrol Deputy, Investigator, Task Force Officer, and supervisor. He is engaged in the lives of his loving family and the betterment of his community.

On the morning of January 4, 2024, Sheriff Infante was pulling into his office when an active shooter call was broadcast over the police radio. The efforts of Sheriff Infante and the entirety of law enforcement in Dallas County, before, during, and after, helped mitigate the negative impacts of the shooter's actions and aid in the recovery of the students, staff, and community impacted by the events inside Perry High School.
